1	Spinning Tray(Chandraki), Bamboo Make	Mat size 6'x4' made of seasoned bamboo split not more than 1" wide a) Front bata-4nos. 2 length wise size 6'8"x1"x1/4" & 2nos. breadth wise 4'8"x1"1/4" b) Back batta-10 nos. 2 nos. length wise 6'8"x1"x1/4" should be passed through the mat. Backside of the chandraki cross batta 2 nos. size 7'8"x1/2" x1/2" 6 nos breadth wise -4'8"x1"x1/4". During setting spiral, knot should be given 2.5" intervals fitted with best quality of jute thread wide of spirals-3", gap between two spiral not more than 2", no. of round spiral in the chandraki will not be less than 34 & 22 in length wise & breadth wise respectively. All battas are both front and back side of the mat tied by a iron wire with 2.5 round in each binding horizontally & 8 binding vertically.	Rs./Pc
2	Rearing Tray(Dalla), Bamboo Make	DALLA (Rearing Tray) :- Size 6'X4', inner area made by neatly weaved seasoned bamboo splits 1/4 " width each (chatai), sides are strengthened by 1 1/2 " width bamboo splits(bata) which are tied by nylon threads at 6 points at lengthwise and 5 points at breadth wise. At the back surface 4 batas of 1 1/2 "width are to be fitted lengthwise and tied properly to give proper support.	Rs./Pc
3	Rearing Tray (Plastic make)	Branded with ISI marked, Food Grade quality. Size-3' x 2' x 4" with all sides perforated.	Rs./Pc
