MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2025-2026

- 727 acres, 249 acres, 28 acres & 50 acres land were so far brought under new Mulberry plantation, Tasar host plantation, Muga host plantation & Eri host plantation against the annual target of 800 acres, 400 acres, 40 acres, and 60 acres respectively.
- A comprehensive Programme with target of 2400 MT Raw Silk including 45 MT of Bivoltine Silk under Mulberry sector and about 39 MT Silk including 160 Kgs of precious Muga Silk in Non-Mulberry sector by the end of the March, 2026 is under implementation.
- About 176 acres of land have been brought under Tasar host plantation through State Development Scheme & Agro-forestry development component of RKVY for improvement of livelihood through Tasar Culture.
- Skill up-gradation and capacity building training programme for about 160 women Tasar Reelers, 40 Tasar Weavers and 50 Mulberry Reelers on improved package of practices is conducted by engaging Master Technicians / Weaver under State Development Schemes.
- Assistance have been provided for construction 483 nos Silkworm Rearing House, establishment of 11 nos Macro Chawki Rearing Centre, 5 Grainage Buildings, new host plantation in 512 acres land, supply of 1430 sets Rearing equipment, establishment of 4 nos Hot Air dryer, installation of 1 MRM and supply of 2826 sets Prophylactic Measures both in Mulberry and Vanya Sector.
- Under Special Schemes, 12472 no beneficiaries are being supported with maintenance of Chawki Rearing Centre, rearing of Bivoltine and Cross-Breed DFLs, strengthening of Registered Seed Producers (RSP), Tasar host plantation
- The Directorate works on developing a vibrant and sustainable farmer base by overall improvement in Production, Productivity & Product Quality through expansion of area under host plantation with special emphasis on Bivoltine and Muga Silk sector.
