



MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2024-2025

- 631 acres, 261 acres, 17 acres & 34 acres land were so far brought under new Mulberry plantation, Tasar host plantation, Muga host plantation & Eri host plantation against the annual target of 800 acres, 400 acres, 40 acres, and 60 acres respectively.
- A comprehensive Programme with target of 2300 MT Raw Silk including 40 MT of Bivoltine Silk under Mulberry sector and about 38 MT silk including 150 kgs of precious Muga Silk in Non-Mulberry sector by the end of the March, 2024 is under implementation.
- About 130 acres of land has been brought under Tasar host plantation under Agro-forestry development component of RKVY for improvement of livelihood through Tasar Culture.
- Skill up-gradation and Capacity building training programme for about 260 Seri-farmers and entrepreneurs on improved package of practices is implemented by engaging Master Technicians under State Development Schemes.
- Assistance have been provided for construction of 104 reeling shed, supply of 50 sets equipment for smart Tasar culture, strengthening of 20 Tasar Graineur groups, establishment of 25 nos 2-basin reeling units etc under RKVY.
- Assistance have been provided for construction 672 nos Silkworm Rearing House, establishment of 16 nos Macro Chawki Rearing Centre, supply of 1674 sets Rearing equipment, establishment of 5 nos Hot Air dryer, support for strengthening of 37 Registered Seed Producers (RSP), supply of 145 nos Tasar Reeling machines etc under Special Schemes of SDS.
